COVID-19

Thank you for your co-operation this week with regard to the one-way system in place at the end of each day. Please can you continue to enter the playground from St Pauls Avenue, collect your children and leave the yard as soon as possible. If you need to leave via St. Pauls Avenue, please now do so via the identified exit point at the gate. If not, continue across the playground and out at the exit on Aberystwyth Crescent.

Other Guidance:

Anyone unwell with symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive in the last 10 days or have been contacted by Test, Trace, Protect with the direction to isolate, **will stay at home.**

- New continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss of/change in taste or smell

If identified as a close contact, parents / carers will be contacted by TTP to let them know. Individuals will be offered two PCR tests and provided with information and advice on how to minimise the risks of onward spread.

Wider Symptoms: Anyone who has any of the wider symptoms of COVID-19 (fatigue, myalgia, sore throat, headache, sneezing, loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea) should seek a PCR test.

All visitors to **wear masks** when inside the school building.

Social Distancing: Where possible, all individuals will maintain a distance and reduce the amount of time they are in face-to-face contact.
