Fruit or vegetables only

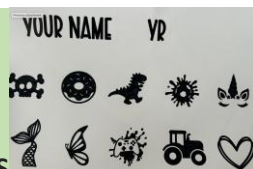
No crisps, chocolate, biscuits, or processed snacks
