Article of the week: 24 – You have the right to good food and water and to see a doctor if you are ill.

### News

This week we have seen a reduction in the number of positive Covid tests across the school. Thank you for your support. We continue to ask that you do not send children to school if someone in the household or your child is awaiting a PCR test result.

If there is a positive case in your household, children still have the right to attend school but we ask that the safest decisions are made to stop the spread of Covid, protecting each other and the most vulnerable within our community.

### COVID-19

**Anyone** unwell with symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive in the last 10 days or have been contacted by Test, Trace, Protect with the direction to isolate, **will stay at home.**

#### Symptoms of Covid-19:

- New continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss of/change in taste or smell

#### Guidance:

- If identified as a **close contact**, parents / carers will be contacted by TTP to let them know.
- **Wider Symptoms:** Anyone who has any of the wider symptoms of COVID-19 (fatigue, myalgia, sore throat, headache, sneezing, loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea) should seek a PCR test.
- All visitors to **wear masks** when inside the school building.
- **Social Distancing:** Where possible, all individuals will maintain a distance and reduce the amount of time they are in face-to-face contact.
